Label Makers	Description	Who is it best for?
<u>Lark Labels</u>	Offers a high variety of custom sign types, sign displays, and sign fastening techniques. Can be shipped outside of the United States.	Great for any size arboreta who need a variety of sign and tag resources.
<u>Plants Map Tags</u>	Allows users to order tags directly from their collections in their Plants Map database. Features a QR Code on the tag to link the specific plant to its information on Plants Map.	Good for any size arboreta, especially those interested in the web-based Plants Map community.
Amazon <u>Labels</u> and <u>Stamp</u> <u>Set</u>	User can create their own signs by purchasing aluminum tags in bulk. They can also purchase a letter and number stamp set to more easily create the tag. Many different vendors and products available, search "tree tags" on Amazon.com. Overall much more economical.	Small to medium arboreta that do not have as much funding or staff to create the tags and have few woody species. HOW TO USE
