ORIGINAL PLANTINGS

Trees and shrubs selected as part of George E. Patton & Associates 1976 design plan stand today and honor Louise Moore's gift to the community.

BICENTENNIAL GROVE

Five eastern hemlocks, Pennsylvania's state tree, commemorate the 1987 bicentennial of the signing of the U.S. Constitution.

MATSON'S WOODS

A seven-acre forest of centuries-old red and white oaks complements the surrounding open landscape and the visitor experience.

AGROFORESTRY PLOTS

Sixty grafted trees (cultivars) from the John Hershey Nut & Edible Fruit Tree Nursery & Farm in Downingtown, PA, create new generations of these historical trees and allow John Hershey's life's work to live on.

SALEM OAK

A seedling grafted from a twig of the famous 600-year-old Salem oak of Salem County, NJ, carries on the name and legacy of this celebrated tree.

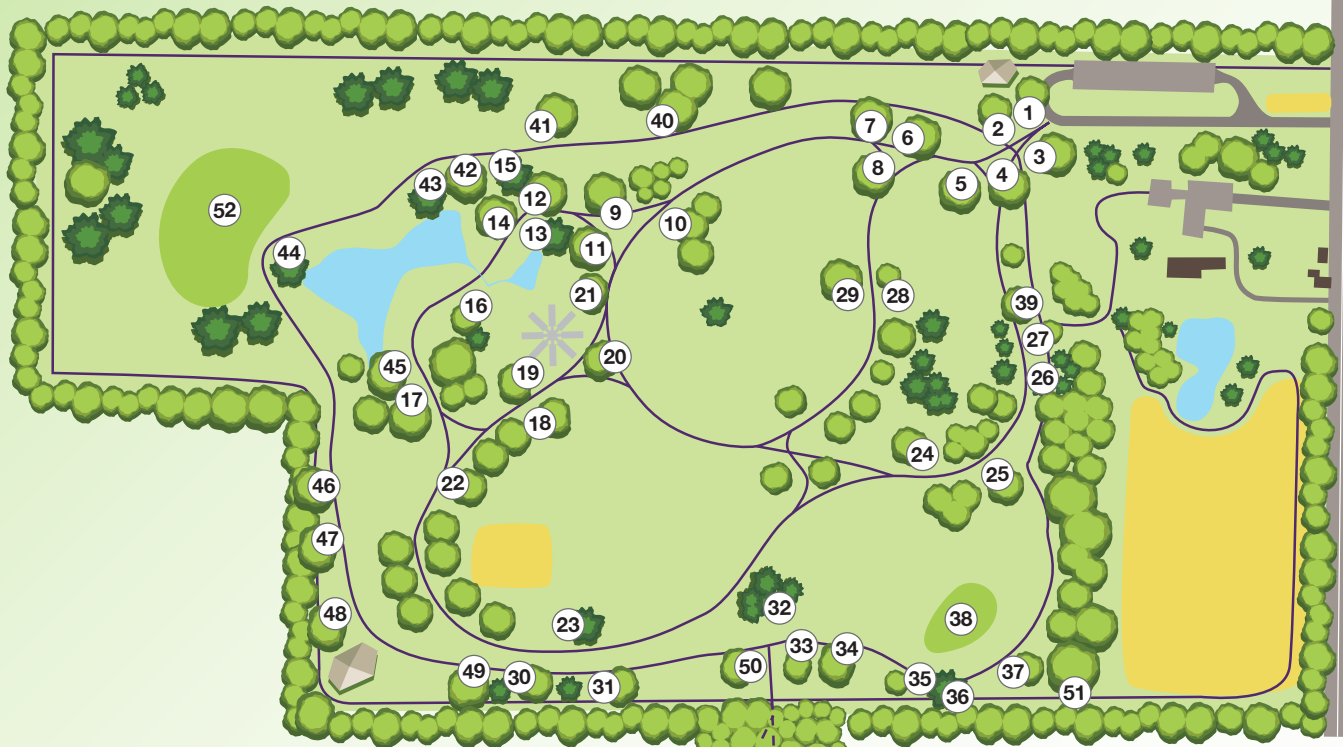
